Owner Zuhal Sari provides great vegan waffles and sandwiches, as well as vegetarian and gluten free options. At Twin Cities Veg Fest, Kitty Corner will be selling Turkish style vegan waffles served with fruit, nuts, and powdered sugar.

Zuhal named her café in honor of her companion animals. She has two cats, Fistik and Findik—Pistachio and Hazelnut in English. She is committed to donating a portion of Kitty Corner Cafe profits to no-kill animal shelters.
